History

Sonic Guild was founded in 2013 in Austin, Texas with the intent to provide support for local music just as more traditional art forms such as the ballet, opera and symphony have been supported for generations.

Impact

Since our founding in 2013, we have distributed \$5,700,000 to over 250 bands and local music businesses – \$1,200,000 of that in 2022 alone.

Vision

Sonic Guild will establish a network of dozens of connected communities around the world which will provide significant financial and professional support for our local music ecosystems, ultimately provisioning tens of millions in grants and services in the support of exceptional new music every year.

Membership Levels

Single Membership

- Access to your chapter's full season of member events
- Space permitting, purchase an additional ticket for each event
- 1 vote for your chapter's artist nominations and grant allocations

Duo Membership

- Access to your chapter's full season of member events
- 1 complimentary guest for each member event
- 1 vote for your chapter's artist nominations and grant allocations


Party Membership

- Access to your chapter's full season of member events
- 3 complimentary guests for each member event
- 1 vote for your chapter's artist nominations and grant allocations

FAQ: Why does each Membership Level only receive 1 vote?

Each membership is tied to one account holder and email. Therefore, it is not possible to have more than one vote for a membership.

Should you and your partner both wish to nominate artists each season you may both purchase a "Single" membership.





Sonic Guild Seasons



You get to experience the best bands in your city at our Nomination Season events, ultimately nominating those you love to become that year's class of Sonic Guild Artists.



Once selected, you will get to know your Sonic Guild Artists through our season of live, intimate concerts exclusively for our members and your invited guests.



Our season ends with you voting for your favorite Sonic Guild Artists to determine the size grant they will receive at our Sonic Guild Ball.



Where Your Member Dues Go

Sonic Guild is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization. The charitable portion of your membership contributions are tax deductible to the extent allowed by law. Please contact your tax advisor and keep this receipt for your tax records.

Payment for Membership Dues is considered 80% charitable. The remaining 20% is the fair market value for goods received – this represents the amount budgeted towards the multiple annual performances that are available for members and their quests to attend.

Your dues fund the payments to the musicians who perform at our events as well as to the grants we award each year. Your funds stay in the chapter of which you are a member! While we are a multi-chapter organization, your contributions stay local and are never used in another chapter or for any auxiliary program.

Sonic Guild receives additional funding from grants, sponsorships and donations to fuel our operations and expansion. We encourage anyone who would like to become a sponsor or donor to contact us and do so!




If you wish to pay your dues via a Corporate Match Program or Donor-Advised Fund, you must follow the below steps:

- Go to your <u>Member Profile</u> and click "Renew" to initiate your membership renewal. Do not make a payment on the invoice.
- Go to membership.sonicguild.org/corpmatch-daf to submit your 20% non-charitable portion of dues to activate your membership.
- Based on whether you are using a DAF or corporate match program, follow your respective necessary procedure for the **remaining 80%** portion of your dues.
- Email membership@sonicguild.org to let them know to expect a match or DAF payment for the remainder of your dues.

NOTE: Payments are processed at the end of each month, which may cause a delay in your balance being updated. Contact membership if you have questions.







Registering for Events

The Community Portal is also where members can view and RSVP for any upcoming events. Simply click the Events tab on the top toolbar to view them all. To RSVP, click on an event, which will redirect you to the event's page. Click "RSVP Here" on the event description and you will be taken to a ticket page where you can click the "Register" button to complete your sign up.

If something comes up and you can no longer attend an event, we ask that you go into your **Event Registrations** (can be accessed either from the Home Page of Community, under the button "View Your Event Registrations" or under your Member System Profile \rightarrow Event Registrations) and cancel your registration.



Referring Prospective Members

Do you know other local music lovers that may be interested in joining the organization? Bring them to an event so they can see what we are all about! Getting tickets for Prospective Members is simple – just fill out our **Prospective Member Form** and you're done! Your guest should be emailed a set of tickets immediately.

NOTE: We need this form to only be used for **genuine prospects**. If we see you are using a variation of your own email address, or are repeatedly inviting the same people to many events and they are not true prospects, we will stop allowing them to be invited. If you are wanting to invite a friend or family member visiting from out of town who is not a true Prospect, please email **membership@sonicguild.org** to ask instead of using the Prospective Member form. This helps our team maintain a dashboard of contacts that are actual prospects, not just one-off guests.







Forum Help:

If you are a monthly recurring member, you do not need to worry about manually renewing each month – you will have a card on file that pulls each month. If a payment fails, you will receive an email notification.

If you are an annual payer and do not already have a payment method on file, go to your Member Profile and click "Renew" to initiate your membership renewal. Pay the invoice normally, unless you are paying via Corporate Match or a Donor-Advised Fund. See slide 7 for details on how to renew under those methods.

The payment method used to complete the invoice will automatically store for future renewals. **You can easily remove that payment method from you**Member Profile at any time.
